Program Description – Registration Form

Program: The World Languages Program (WLP) is a tuition-based, extra-curricular enrichment activity offered at many D97 schools. At Beye it is offered for all grades, including Kindergarten. WLP teachers expose your child to Spanish, German, French, and Mandarin (Chinese) through games, songs, and classroom discussions. WLP supplements Beye's in-curricular Spanish program and provides instruction in other languages. WLP is administered by the Beye PTO through parent volunteers who serve on the WLP committee.

Teachers:

Mandarin (Chinese) Hai Tao Huang has a degree in music performance and teaches music theory and trumpet at UIC. He has taught Mandarin Chinese at Lincoln School for the past three and one half years.

French Orly Slobodkin has a master's degree in French literature from the Sorbonne in Paris and teaches French using the method of "total physical response."

German Lisa Peters has been teaching German to elementary school students at District 90 and 97 schools for over 20 years.

Mandarin (Chinese) (K - 5th grade)

Instructor: Hai Tao Huang

This class teaches conversation and vocabulary using picture-based materials. Children learn speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Activities include singing and crafts.

French (K - 5th grade)

Instructor: Orly Slobodkin

This class teaches French using the method of "total physical response." Learning French through actions is an excellent way to naturally develop conversation and build vocabulary.

German (K - 5th grade)

Instructor: Lisa Peters

An activity/project oriented class for a mixed-age group where each child works at his/her own rate in the target language of German. Activities include games, songs, rhymes and stories. The main project each year will focus on a new vocabulary base, rotating between such groupings as: clothing, body parts, food, animals, weather, house and furniture, school, etc.

Payment is due at the time of registration. Families with more than one student enrolled in the Beye PTO World Languages Program may pay in two installments, with full payment due by November 20th or February 20th. Pick Up Procedures: Parents/guardians are responsible for picking up their children on time at the end of class from the program teacher or designated monitor. If parents/ guardians cannot pick up a child on time they should arrange with a friend, neighbor or family member for a timely pick up. If a child is not picked up at the end of class the program teacher, monitor, or administrator will contact parents using the emergency contact number(s) to make arrangements for pick up. After waiting ten minutes, the teacher or monitor will proceed with the following emergency protocol. At no time will a program teacher or monitor leave a student without adult supervision.

1. After waiting ten minutes the teacher or monitor may turn the child over to the Beye Elementary School office who will continue to call parents at their emergency numbers to arrange for pick up.
2. If the office is closed or if the office cannot reach a parent/guardian before closing, Jonathan Ellwanger, Principal of Beye School, should be called on his cell phone.
3. If Mr. Ellwanger cannot be reached, the call of last resort should be to the Oak Park Police Department at 708-386-2131 for assistance.

If parents/guardians arrive consistently late for pickup, the student will no longer be able to participate in the class. Working together we hope that these procedures and protocols will never have to be utilized. They exist to insure that students will always be safe and supervised.
